

# NOTICE OF RACE

---

## 1. RULES

---

- 1.1.** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-24
- 1.2.** The prescriptions of FIV Italian Sailing Federation shall apply
- 1.3.** Boats shall comply with World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations- For inshore races (Category 4).
- 1.4.** If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

## 2. ADVERTISING

---

- 2.1.** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

---

- 3.1.** The regatta is open to all boats of that have competed in either The Whitbread or the Volvo Ocean Race.
- 3.2.** Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, to: [marie.bage@ext.theoceanrace.com](mailto:marie.bage@ext.theoceanrace.com)

## 4. FEES

---

- 4.1.** Each entry will be subject to the payment of the "Entry Fee" of €1500.00 to be paid by the 15th of April 2023 (the "Entry Period").

In the event an Entry is not filed and paid on before the Entry Period the entry fee will increase to €2000.00 (the "Late Entry Fee").

## 5. THE REGATTA

---

- 5.1.** The regatta will consist of a coastal handicap race. Handicaps determined by The Ocean Race Management team.

## 6. SCHEDULE

---

- 6.1.** Registration: Boats shall arrive on the 23rd June 2023 and register on Saturday 24th June 2023 0800hrs to 1800hrs .
- 6.2.** Inspection: Spot safety checks may be carried out at any time.
- 6.3.** Skippers Briefing: Will be held at 6pm on Monday 26th June venue TBA
- 6.4.** Date of racing: The 50th Anniversary Legends Regatta will be on Tuesday 27th June 2023. The warning signal shall be 13.55hrs.
- 6.5.** All boats taking part in The 50th Anniversary Legends Regatta will have further obligations to enhance the guest experience at the Genova stopover. This will be outlined in full well before the event.
- 6.6.** Boats will remain at the venue until the 3rd July 2023.

## 7. MEASUREMENTS

---

**7.1.** There will be no measurement.

## 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

---

**8.1.** The sailing instructions will be available after registration: if not sent by email before.

## 9. VENUE

---

**9.1.** Map of venue and the location of the regatta harbour shown further down.

## 10. THE COURSES

---

**10.1.** The courses to be sailed will be coastal type, for a race lasting approximately 3 hours

## 11. SUPPORT BOATS

---

**11.1.** Support boats shall be marked to identify them with the boat they are associated with. Support boat will not be permitted to berth within the Ocean Race assembly area.

## 12. BERTHING

---

**12.1.** Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the harbour. Boats shall be in their assigned berth on the 23rd June 2023 to the 3rd July 2023.

## 13. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

---

**13.1.** Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

## 14. PRIZES

---

**14.1.** Prizes will be awarded for the first finisher and the first three after handicap. Special prizes may also be awarded for best maintained yacht, personality of the event, 'champagne moment' etc,(to be nominated).

## 15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

---

**15.1.** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 16. INSURANCE

---

**16.1.** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 3 million per incident.
