# CEREMONY

Relay4Nature is an initiative by The Ocean Race and UN Secretary-General's Special Envoy for the Ocean, Peter Thomson, to help give the ocean a voice on the critical issues affecting our planet at the landmark events where decisions are made about the environment. It connects the threats to the natural world and calls on world leaders to radically increase their ambitions to protect and restore the ocean.

During the 2022-23 edition of The Ocean Race, Nature's Baton continues its journey around the world sailing with participating teams in the race of a lifetime. It sailed from Alicante to Cabo Verde with Team Malizia, where it was handed to the UN Secretary General, António Guterres. The Baton then sailed from Cabo Verde to Cape Town with the Biotherm crew and from Cape Town to Itajaí, Brazil, with Team Holcim - PRB. 11th Hour Racing brought it to their hometown, Newport, and, in solidarity with Guyot, not able to participate in Leg 5 of the Race, Malizia's Rosalin Kuiper received it to bring it to Aarhus. Team Jajo will sail with it to The Hague, The Netherlands.



Team Malizia received the Nature's Baton, the symbol of Relay4Nature, at the Race start in Alicante, and skipper Boris Herrmann delivered it to the Prime Minister of Cabo Verde at The Ocean Race Mindelo in January 2023.


