


A UNIQUE SPACE IN THE WORLD

RACE CONTROL

Described by the media as 'The Nasa of the sea', Race Control is the only point in the world where every movement of the fleet is controlled and monitored during race time. It is the most advanced control room ever built for a sailing race and also the boat crews' contact with the mainland.

With an 18-screen video wall, eight control stations and the central platform of a traditional and electronic chart table, this sophisticated centre provides constant monitoring and analysis of all the boats in the fleet.

In a unique setting next to Race Control, this room becomes a space to hold any type of event, product presentation, exhibitionS, a conventions workshops...


It has high ceilings and side access through a garage door to allow for the introduction of large pieces.
